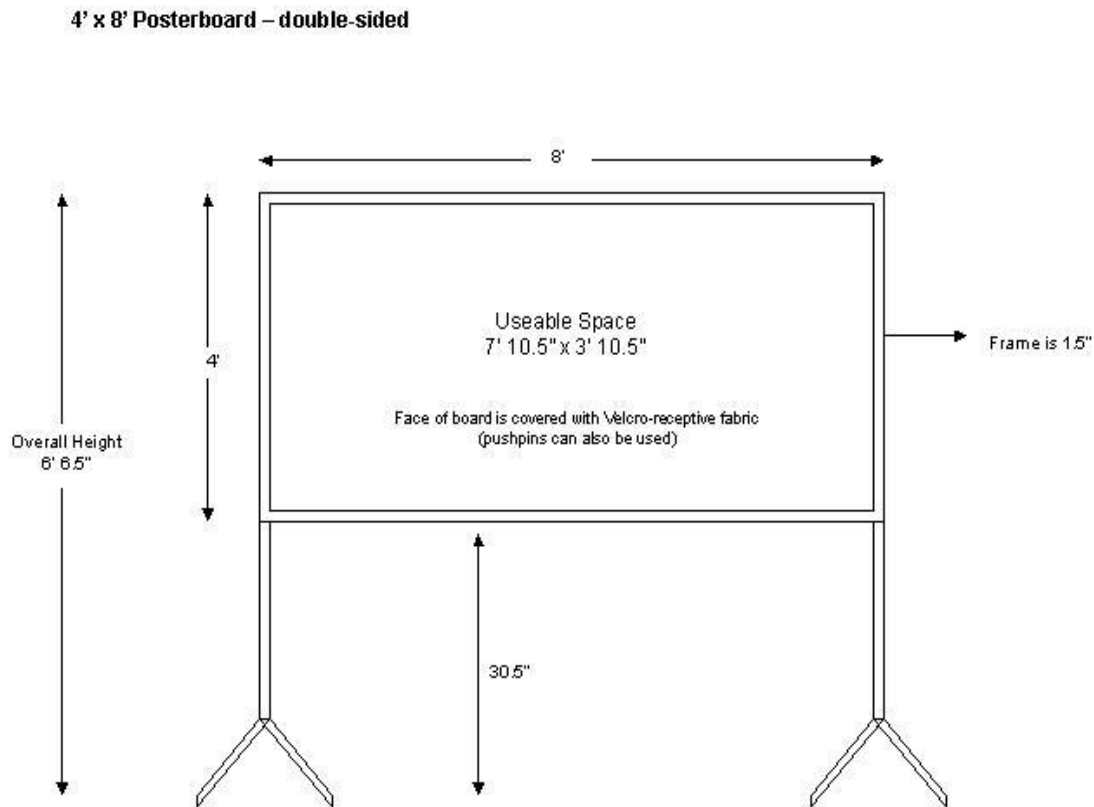


**POSTER PRESENTER INFORMATION**

Poster authors will have one (1) landscape, 4' x 8' poster board to mount their posters on for viewing. The board has a frame (edges) of approximately 1.5" per side. The usable surface area of each poster is 7' 7" wide by 3' 9" high. Presenters will use **ONE SIDE** of the poster board. Presenters should plan for a maximum poster size of 91" wide by 45" high (231 cm x 114 cm). Each board will have the presenter's poster number on it (which will be provided ahead of time), and pushpins will be available for use. Please view the sketch below for a sample 4' x 8' poster board.
